	As of April 1, 2021, 19 jurisdictions have laws regulating unpaid school meal charges.
	Jurisdictions: 19 (AR, CA, HI, IL, IA, LA, ME, MD, MN, NH, NJ, NM, NY, OR, PA, TX, VA, WA, WV)
	Alternative Meals
	Nine jurisdictions prohibit giving children alternative meals when they are unable to pay.
	Jurisdictions: 9 (AR, CA, IL, IA, ME, NM, OR, WA, WV)

Two jurisdictions authorize schools to employ debt collectors to collect unpaid debt.
